Co,/Norma Talmadge Corp." at the center.

This publication, along with a reproduction of Mr. Sondheim's original score, are certainly scarce.



Stephen Sondheim's *Road Show*, the tale of the Mizner brothers traversing America during the Florida real estate boom and Klondike gold rush, has a complicated history. A musical on the same subject was originally conceived by Irving Berlin in the early 1950s. The show was titled *The Last Resorts*, *Palm Beach*, *The Mizner Story*, and *Sentimental Guy* but was eventually completed by Berlin as *Wise Guy*, a show that despite all the effort was never produced. Simultaneously, Stephen Sondheim began working on a musical based on the book *The Last Resorts* by Cleveland Amory but put his idea aside when he learned about Berlin's project. Decades later, Mr. Sondheim picked up the musical, which was produced under the title *Wise Guys* in 1999. The show was largely rewritten again in 2003, retitled *Bounce*, and staged in a production that reunited Mr. Sondheim with director Harold Prince with whom he had not collaborated since 1981.

In 2008, Mr. Sondheim again reworked the musical, now retitled *Road Show*, and it was produced at the Public Theater in the fall. The present piano-vocal score has a cover sheet with the notation "Road Show (prev. Bounce - retitled August 13, 2008) and the score itself has printed labels reading "Road Show" affixed over the title "Bounce (2008)." This is a wonderful relic of a musical reworked by Mr. Sondheim over six decades.

In the late 1960s, Stephen Sondheim devised a weekly cryptic crossword puzzle for the back pages of New York Magazine, then in its first years of publication; finding it too time-consuming, he backed off to every three weeks and suggested his friend, the talented wordsmith Mary Ann Madden, provide content for the weeks in between. Ms. Madden created the popular wordplay New York Magazine Competition, in which players would at first mail and later email in responses. Ms. Madden created 973 competitions over a 32-year career at the magazine (the largest response was once 9000 postcards).

"The Game of Stardom or Camp" - An elaborate handmade Sondheim-invented board game

The board measures 18 1/2 x 18 1/2 inches; the game's components comprise, an 8 pp. typewritten rulebook; the original hand-made game board, hand-drawn and painted in ink, watercolor, and paint on paper, with metallic star stickers and gold letter stickers, apparently pasted over a store-bought folding game board; 79 "Bid" cards on white paper housed in a card box, 23 pink paper "Star Cards," and 63 blue paper "Star Cards," all cards are typewritten on fronts and backs, with metallic stars stickers on backs; a wallpaper-covered box **containing the "accouterments" of a Hollywood star**, including 5 "mink stoles," made of scraps cut from a fur stole or coat, a variety of plastic and metal jewelry including bracelets, rings, earrings, and brooches and the remnants of a few pairs of cheap sunglasses, as well as four sheets of paper with "mink stole" typed on one side, a plastic box of sequins, two packs of extra metallic star stickers, and an empty small Bloomingdale's box; and a professionally printed pad of "Starsheets." Wear commensurate with age and use; the game board does not lie flat, it is rubbed and starting to split at edges along the fold, the tape border is coming unstuck in a few places and there is some faint staining and toning to the reverse; the rules are lightly toned, with some creasing, and offsetting from a rusty paperclip; the cards have some toning and soiling with some foil star stickers starting to lift, the "Bids" card box is toned; the "Accouterments" box is worn, waterstained, and defective, but is still holding together, the condition of the contents varies - the "mink stoles" appear fine, the plastic jewelry is fine, some of the metal jewelry is tarnished, the sunglasses have mostly disintegrated, but the lenses are present; one sheet from the "Starsheet" pad is detached and lightly toned, otherwise as new; according to the equipment list the 16 "Item Cards" are missing from the game, sold as is; Together with, A fascinating archive relating to Stephen Sondheim's efforts to copyright, revamp, and produce "The Game of Stardom" commercially. 1953 and 1960. The archive comprises A typed signed letter from Stephen Sondheim "To Whom it May Concern," dated November 17, 1953, registering "the rules, regulations, description of equipment, and necessary diagrams of the game tentatively called "Stardom," which is my own invention and the product of my sole imagination" with the United States Post Office. Sondheim then states,

"that I intend to market this game commercially... with the explicit purpose of making a financial profit;" together with a 2-page signed typewritten document titled "Revisions, variations, and

its rules and equipment, for the purpose of making it more appealing to the public and therefore more liable to prove commercially profitable," dated November 17th, 1953 in the text, with a manuscript addition in ink on the recto and in pencil on the verso of the first page, the document deals with various changes to the game such as adding male accoutrements, alternate titles such as "Success, changing the instructions "on the Star Cards... so as not to offend any of the Stars," as well as the possibility of publishing other versions of the game that deal with other industries such as Television, Literature, or, of course, Broadway a 1-page typed document titled "Order of Names on the Game Board...", listing 53 stars popular in 1960 including Audrey Hepburn, Elizabeth Taylor, and Marilyn Monroe, with manuscript annotation stating "

(esquire version - 1960) in ink at the upper right-hand corner; a 3-page typewritten document titled "Party Cards," listing revamped texts for 48 potential cards, with manuscript annotation stating "(esquire version - 1960) in ink at the upper right-hand corner; A photo-copied draft of the game's board, with manuscript annotations on the recto verso, printed on coated blue paper. Light toning and creasing to the letter and documents, with the ghost of a paperclip in the upper left, the sheet with the photo-copied board is toned and dampstained, not affecting the pencil annotations.

This is a remarkable survival from Stephen Sondheim's early days, likely the most complete Sondheim-invented game still extant, and with a fascinating archive that shows Sondheim toying with the idea of becoming a board game designer at a young age, decades before he threatened to leave Broadway to design

computer games and puzzles.

In 1953, soon after graduating from Williams College, Sondheim briefly moved to Los Angeles to work as a screenwriter on the television series, *Topper*. His mother, Foxy, was also living in Los Angeles after marrying a man who worked at CBS-TV. While in Hollywood, Sondheim had the advantage of his mother and stepfather's movie contacts, allowing him to attend some glamorous Hollywood parties, and even meet certain stars like Humphrey Bogart, Irene Dunne, and Grace Kelly. Sondheim had an enduring love and vast knowledge of cinema, especially the golden age of Hollywood, which this game attests to. Later on, he tried to make a musical out of *Sunset Boulevard*, apparently one of his favorite films, but abandoned the plan after Billy Wilder told him it would only work as an opera.

Sondheim was initially inspired to make this game by a Hollywood map to the stars - "And it suddenly suggested a game to me, so I invented this game, very elaborate and quite good, called Stardom, about how you fuck your way to the top, literally. The board, which my mother painted -that was her contribution-is made of eighty homes of stars in the categories of extra, bit player, starlet, and star to Great Star, who is Norma Desmond. She has her own estate in the corner of the board. And you travel around, you get a bid by picking a card from the pack, who you are going to sleep with, and once you sleep with that person it gets you onto the next category. But other people can play Louella Parsons cards and figure out who you're with, and reveal it to the newspaper, which sends you back. By following your moves they can make accusations." As Sondheim's friend Alan Brien remembers, the cards were full of "unprintable, and largely accurate, studio gossip." (Meryle Secrest. *Stephen Sondheim: A Life.* New York: Vintage, 1998. pp. 98 and 240.)

The object of *Stardom*, is to "become a GREAT STAR by getting the highest salary, the most contracts, the most divorces, and sleeping with the most stars." The game is played by up to four players, or "career girls," who begin the game with a cry of "Stars, Stars, shine tonight!" Dice are rolled to move around the board, and the players must visit the actress, or *BID*, whose name they

pulled from the deck of *BID CARDS*. Before accomplishing their *BID*, the players must visit three actresses of each rank, starting with the red names, who are

"extras," then moving on to the blue names, "bit players," and finally up to the silver, "starlets," and lastly on to the gold names, who are "stars.' Players who visit an actress accrue money and STAR CARDS, which contain a variety of rewards or punishments and are also printed with salacious bits of Hollywood gossip. After completing their BID, the player moves up in rank, which they denote by placing the correctly colored sequin on their face. Then the process starts over again with the drawing of a new BID CARD for an actress of the next higher rank. Players cannot sleep with their BID unless they receive or purchase the necessary "accouterments" of their BID's rank - thus, to visit a starlet one needs earrings and dark sunglasses, and for a star one needs a diamond ring and a mink stole. Throughout the game, players can accuse each other of trying to sleep with an actress (ie. they can try to guess what BID another player has) by sending one of their four ITEM CARDS (these are not present, but would have been printed with the name of a gossip columnist, either Lolly Parsons, Hedda Hopper, Mike Connolly, or Radie Harris). When accusing another player, "you merely announce... 'I read in Hedda Hopper, darling, where you're sleeping with _!'... If the accusation is true, the other player replies 'It's true, darling, too true.' His OPTION IS IMMEDIATELY DROPPED because of damaged reputation. If, however, your accusation is false, the other player replies, 'It's a goddamn lie!' and collects \$5,000 from you for libel." Additionally, "when one player passes another on the street [in the board], he must should 'Hello, darling' and casually drop the name of a star The other player must reply in kind and drop a different name." The winner of the game is the one who first visits "the great star," Norma Desmond, the main character from Sunset Boulevard. "GOOD LUCK, AND MAY YOU BE GREAT, GREAT STARS! (Watch for the exciting new sequel to STARDOM called STARDOM-ASCOPE, played on a wide board.) (Made in Hollywood)"

purchased for \$10,000 and are worth 1 point; 75 blue "Backers Audition" cards, with varying amounts of money raised on the front of the cards; a number of small yellow cards with actor and actress names; and with a number of cards with the names of four imaginary Broadway producers (Mary L. Magdalene, Dora Mifasol, Snow & Crosby, and Sylvia Dribley) who players can play as on the front, and with "Closing Notice" on the reverse. Light wear and cracking to leather on the box's exterior, the cards with occasional light wear, toning, or dampstaining, all card counts are approximate, the game is missing its Monopoly-style board, without a rulebook; together with, A box marked "extra game equipment," containing additional blank cards for the Broadway producer game, as well two typed cards for a bespoke word game, and a group of cards with printed illustrations of professionals, with their professions crossed out and substituted with humourous titles; the box a bit worn and stained, the cards with occasional light toning; a box containing cut pieces of paper with letters handwritten on one side. "Sondheim had followed up his outrageous "Stardom" game... with a game called "Analysis," in which the pieces you played with were tiny, intricately upholstered couches. Then there was the game invented specifically for Hal Prince, with overtones of Monopoly, in which players had to tackle the pitfalls of negotiating Broadway plays, from raising the money to keeping the play from closing, the object being to take over all the theatres and bankrupt everyone else. It was a game Prince always won" (Meryle Seacrest. Stephen Sondheim: A Life. p. 240).

The Royall & Most Pleasant Game of Y Goose, published in 1670, is among the earliest Game of the Goose boards published in England. It follows a standard format with sixty-three spaces, thirteen of which contain illustrations of geese. The Mansion of Happiness was often cited as the first board game published in America, although scholars have now identified certain earlier geographic games that were published in the 1820s. The game is closely based on an English game of the same name published by Laurie and Whittle in 1800. It has a moralistic message there are spaces representing positive traits such as piety, honesty, and gratitude, and penalty spaces with titles like immodesty, cruelty, or audacity - which was a common theme for games produced by the Salem-based board game publishers William and Stephen Ives, the predecessors of Milton Bradley, the McLoughlin brothers, and Parker Brothers.

Edward Loysel's *Chivalric Game of Tornoy* is a medieval-themed game inspired by chess but with an added element of chance, seeing as the roulette wheel dictates which piece can be moved at each turn during play. Loysel, a Parisian civil engineer, patented his game and its roulette wheel-spinning apparatus in London in 1854. Between Mr. Sondheim's two sets of this rare board game, there are more than enough pieces for a four-player game.

This is a particularly charming set of figural chalks from the late nineteenth century, showcases an eclectic group of men from all walks of life, including a dandy, a beggar, a well-to-do child, a bootblack, a group of soldiers, a hunter, and a Turk.

A rare, early nineteenth-century Game of the Goose-style board game intended to teach children astronomy and certain moral lessons. John Wallis published this game board, which was "revised and approved" by Mrs. Margaret Bryan, the author of several scientific textbooks. Mrs. Bryan ran a girls' school in Blackheath where she, unusually, included subjects often seen as unsuitable for girls such as science and mathematics in her curriculum. "The board has 35 numbered 'squares' depicting astronomical objects, instruments, and principles as well as astronomers (Ptolemy, Tycho Brahe, Nicholas Copernicus, Isaac Newton) and moral lessons (e.g. a studious and idle boy, the county gaol and an army volunteer). One square shows The Man In The Moon as an example of ignorance in astronomy. By spinning a 'te-totum,' players can travel over the board, the object being to spin numbers up to 35 and reach the final 'square', depicting [the Royal Observatory at] Flamsteed House: 'Whoever first arrives here is to take the title of Astronomer Royal'. The game involves much rote learning as well as moral lessons en route: within the rules of the game accuracy of knowledge and zeal are rewarded, while ignorance and idleness are punished." (https://www.rmg.co.uk/collections/objects/rmgcobject-264736). This is a prime example of the nineteenth-century fashion of using games as educational tools. We can locate only 7 institutional examples of this title in various editions.

For example, on "Rattle-Away Road," which is decorated with an illustration of a train, you must "pay 2 for special train." Sometimes, these penalties and rewards have a moralistic thrust, such as "take 2 for being charitable." A player wins the game by being the first to arrive at the idyllic "Cottage of Content," and then receives all the counters that the players had lost throughout the game. The humorous illustrations that populate this board, including a frog band, Robin Hood, a hot air balloon, a sack jumping race, and a cave full of bandits, make this a particularly charming example of a Game of the Goose board.

The board spaces are connected by the body of a fearsome snake, a common trope in Games of the Goose, whose long teeth, forked tongue and barbed tail must have left a lasting impression on the minds of the children who played. 

Around a hundred years after its publication, in 1937, Hermes used this game board as the model for their first silk scarf.

The author, a teacher, violoncellist, composer, and conductor, writes in the pamphlet's preface that he invented the game for his students at Madame de Saint-Varend's boarding school. After seeing positive results, he submitted his system to the famous composer André Grétry, who approved of it and endorsed the game. This is quite a rare survival - no copies have been sold at auction as per Rare Book Hub, and we can only locate a few copies of the work, in either of the two editions, in libraries (BNF, Yale, and Rochester's Eastman School of Music).
